



Fire safety – information about evacuation procedures at Alrek

Everyone in the building is responsible for exiting the building promptly. Close any windows and doors on the way out. Notify everyone you see on the way out.

On the 3rd and 4th floors, there is a fire curtain that closes the main stairway in the event of an alarm, it is therefore important that everyone on these two floors uses the escape route via the A or D wing.

NOTE! NO ONE must use the elevator if the fire alarm goes off. Help those who may need help, or report to the site manager if you know of anyone who needs help.

If the site managers in your wing are not present, others in the wing must take responsibility and put on the yellow vest / check the area.

The site managers in the B- and C-wings are responsible for checking the area in their wings, in addition to the common areas on their floors. The B-wing is responsible for the area between B- and A-wing (evacuate via A-wing)

C-wing is responsible for the area between C- and D-wing (evacuates via D-wing).



If the door to the escape route is locked - press the button for the emergency door release (see picture)



If you are stuck in the staircase between the 2nd and 3rd floor or 3rd and 4th floor, you can press the emergency opener for the fire curtain at the bottom of the stairs (see picture).
